

Aqua Kids Policies

Thank you for participating in our Children's Swim Lessons program. Please observe these policies as they are in place to provide a fun, safe and positive learning environment for your child.

1. Proper swimming attire is required. Babies must wear a swim diaper.
2. Parent(s) must remain in the facility during their child's lesson.
3. Parent(s) may watch the lesson from the pool deck near the windows. We kindly request that parents not talk to the child or interfere with instruction during the lesson.
4. Children are not allowed to enter the water until the instructor has instructed them to do so.
5. Food and drink are NOT allowed in the pool area.
6. Remove all band-aids before entering the water.
7. Horseplay and running are not allowed.
8. Diving or jumping into the pool is not allowed except under the instructors order.
9. Profanity is prohibited at all times.
10. Please arrive on time for your child's lesson.
11. Make up sessions will only be allowed in the event the facility is unavailable due to inclement weather or maintenance.
12. Only children 4 (four) years of age and under may utilize opposite sex locker rooms for changing. (see below for clarification)

IMPORTANT: Entering and Exiting the Aquatics Area

Our pool is most easily accessed via our men's and women's locker rooms. ***Out of respect for our members and for their privacy, please observe the following requests regarding entering and exiting the aquatics area with your child.***

1. Parents accompanying a child under the age of 5 of the opposite gender may enter and exit the aquatics area via the parent-gender appropriate locker room. (i.e. a mother may take a 4 year old boy OR girl through the women's locker room).
2. Parents accompanying a child 5 years of age and older may enter the pool via the parent-gender appropriate locker room with a child of the same gender only. (i.e. a mother may not take a 6 year old boy through the women's locker room).
3. Parents accompanying a child 5 years of age and older of the opposite gender should enter the pool through the "Exit Doors" in the main lobby. A lifeguard will open the door for you.
4. Please be advised that baby changing stations are available in both the men's and women's restrooms in the Rehab Hospital lobby.
